Bar code Scanner Setup

Zebra DS9208



Add an Enter / [CR] to Every Scan

This programs your Zebra DS9208 so that after every barcode it scans, it automatically adds the text [CR]. TORO uses that [CR] to know the input came from the scanner.

Print this page and the following pages, then scan the 7 barcodes IN ORDER, one at a time. Wait for the beep after each one before scanning the next.

Scan these, in this exact order:

1. Begin New Rule
2. Send All Data That Remains
3. Send [
4. Send C
5. Send R
6. Send]
7. Save Rule

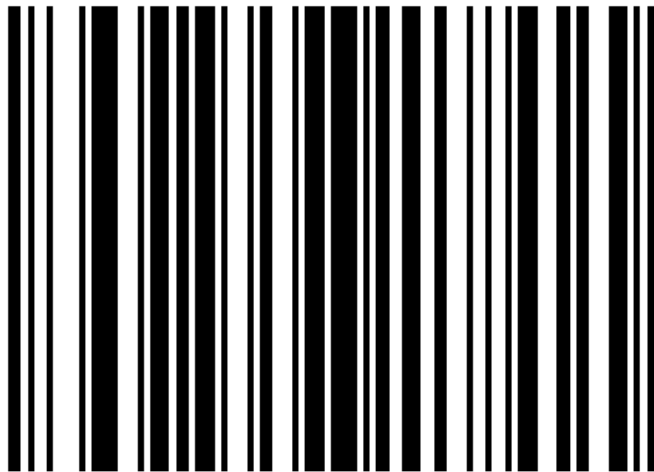
Tip: The rule applies to ALL barcode types automatically - there is nothing to choose for symbology.

To test: open Notepad and scan any product barcode. You should see the digits followed by [CR], for example 012345678905[CR] - if you see that, it worked. In TORO the [CR] is used automatically and is not shown.

To start over: if you lose your place, just begin again at step 1 (Begin New Rule). The scanner discards an unfinished rule.

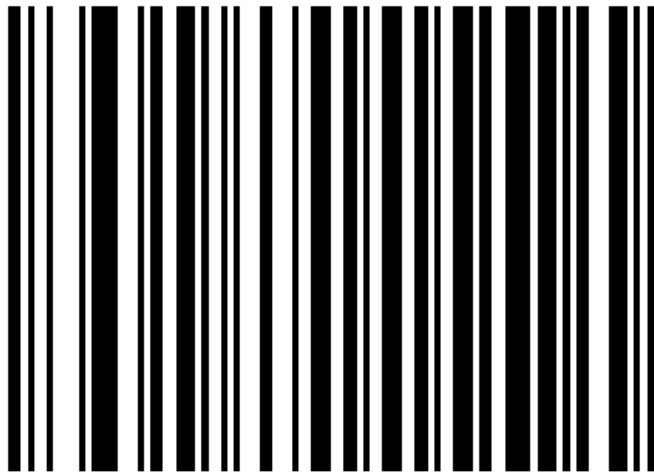

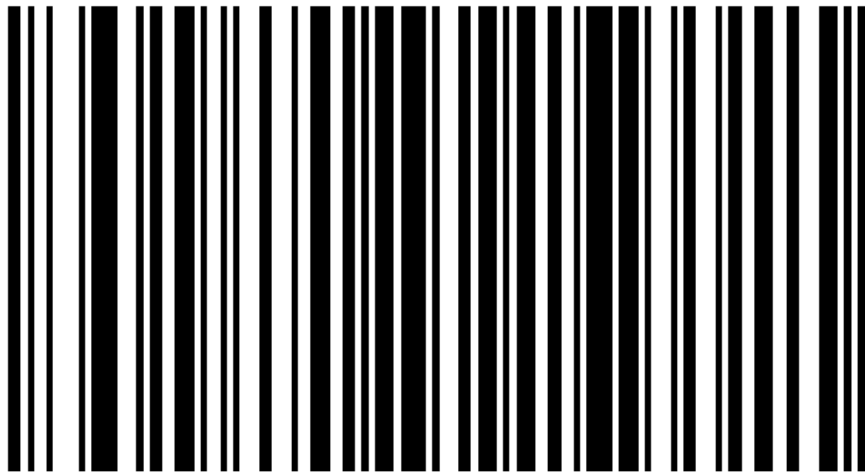

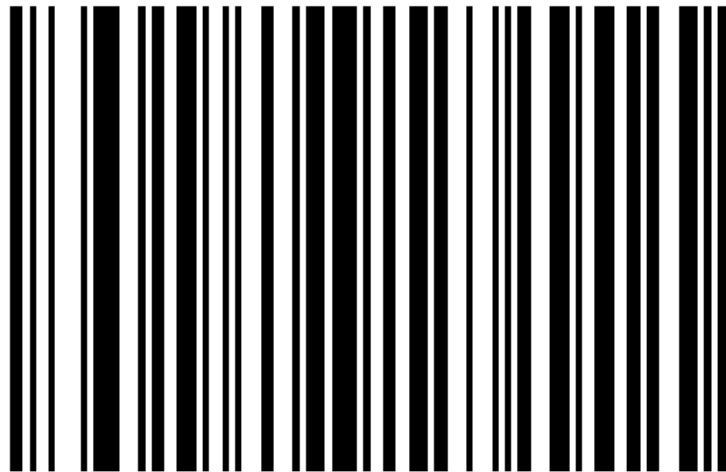

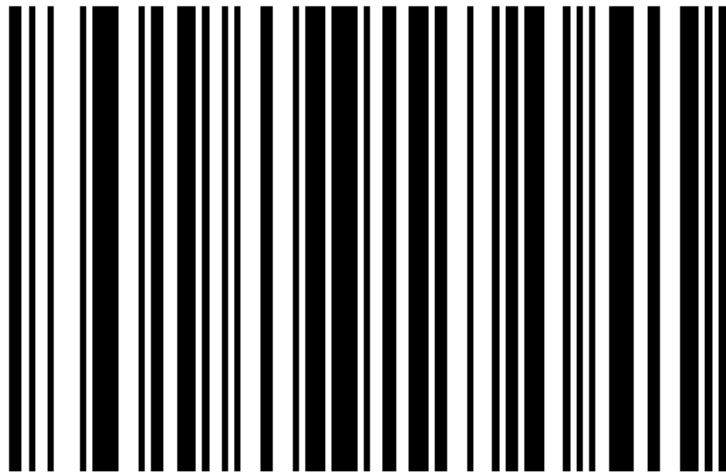
Send C

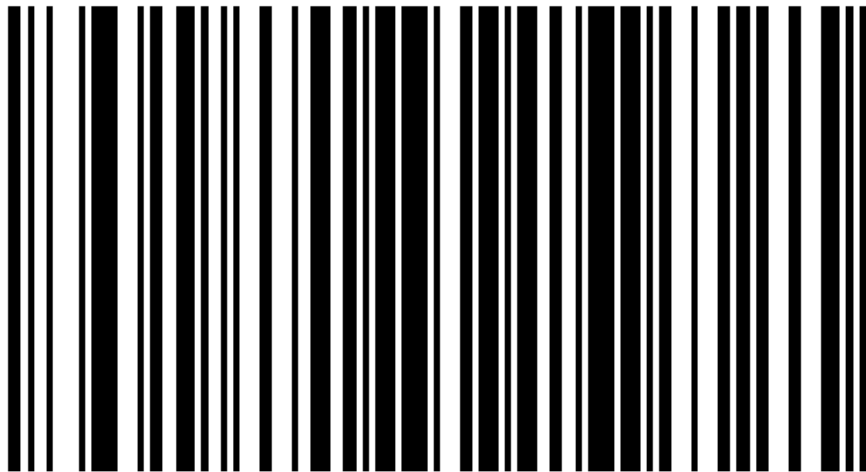
Send R

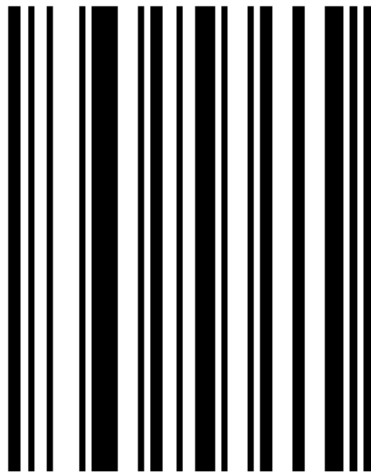
Send] (right bracket)

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Factory Reset (Optional)

Scan the barcode below ONLY if you want to erase ALL scanner settings and return the Zebra DS9208 to its factory defaults.

WARNING: This also removes the [CR] rule set up earlier in this document. After a factory reset, re-scan steps 1-7 to add [CR] again.
